The Tactiles have two variants, the Blister Tactile and Corduroy Tactile, and have been developed for use in underground rail networks, where they are being used to designate the platform edge, or the top and base of stairwells. Offering excellent flexibility and slip resistance, - together with colour variations to assist the visually impaired - they comply with London Underground Limited's Engineering Standard E3821 A6.

The SR and SRQ systems are seamless, textured floors ideal for use in all areas subject to high foot and vehicular traffic where health, hygiene and fire-safety are paramount, including underground rail networks, washroom areas, warehousing and storage facilities. Their anti-slip finish maintains colour stability under exposure to UV light, and provide excellent scratch, chemical and wear resistance.

Flowfast Rapid Transit is the latest development from Flowcrete, which has its headquarters in Sandbach, Cheshire, and operates around the world. In the UK alone, Flowcrete spends more than £600,000 on research and development – globally amounting to £1.3m.
